

QUALIFYING FOR PERSONAL AWARDS (Driver of the Year, Rookie of the Year, Hard Luck, Most Improved)

To be nominated/voted on for a personal award.....

Drivers will be nominated/voted on by the other drivers/members of the PA Lawn Mower Racing Assoc. and their families

A driver may nominate/vote for his/her self.

A tie in votes will be broken by the acting chapter president.

Driver of the Year

- ❖.... This driver will have earned a Championship cup in at least one class.
- ❖.... This driver will have proven his/her talent on and off the track. To name a few examples this driver may have volunteered services during a race, help other competitors, or helped to promote lawn mower racing by registering their mower at a car/tractor show, or received media coverage in either TV or a newspaper story.
- ❖.... This award is for the adult prepared classes only.

Rookie of the Year

- ❖.... This driver will be in his/her first season of competition. This person may not have competed in more than two PALMRA sanctioned events in a previous season UNLESS the driver raced in the JP class. Racing in the JP class will not affect a driver's rookie status when that driver reaches legal age and moves to an adult class.
- ❖.... This award is for the adult prepared classes only.
- ❖.... Drivers eligible for this award will be posted with the awards banquet info.

Most Improved Driver

- ❖.... This award is not open to those drivers who are candidates for the Rookie of the Year award.
- ❖.... To be nominated this driver must have improved his/her points position by one over the previous years standings.
- ❖.... This award is open to drivers in all prepared classes including the JP class.

Hard Luck Award

- ❖.... This award should be given to a driver who has struggled with on track problems through out the season.

This award is open to drivers in all prepared classes including the JP class.
